At age 13, she became a firm Believer in Jesus her Savior and Lord. Subsequently she joined the Ferndale Free Methodist Fellowship and served there in numerous capacities. Many Hazel Park residents will remember her as their elementary school teacher. Meeting former students was always a special delight.
