An Army veteran and member of the Royal Oak V.F.W. Acorn Post #1669, he was an avid golfer and enjoyed playing and watching hockey.

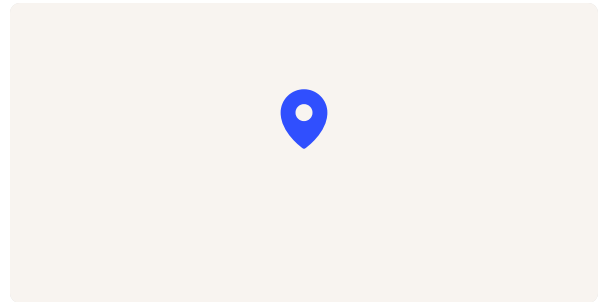
