Goble Jackson, age 92, of Royal Oak, MI passed away October 19, 2014. He was born June 3, 1922 in Hickman County, Kentucky.

Loving son of the late Virgi Burgess and step father Gentry O'Neal. Dear father of E. Ray (Barbara) Jackson. Survived by sister Catherine Etherton. Predeceased by siblings Arlie O'Neal, Homer O'Neal, Adell Rich, Agnes Wooten, Deanie O'Neal and Ruth Bobo. Grandfather of Robert E. Jackson. Great Grandfather of Ethan R. Jackson and Dylan McCallum. 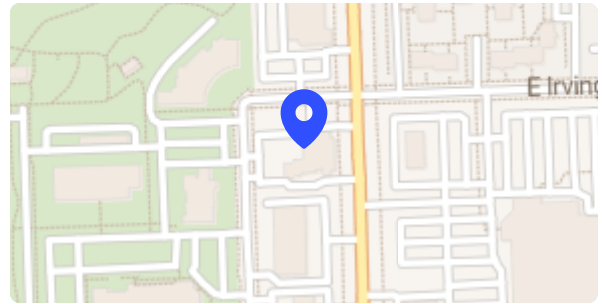

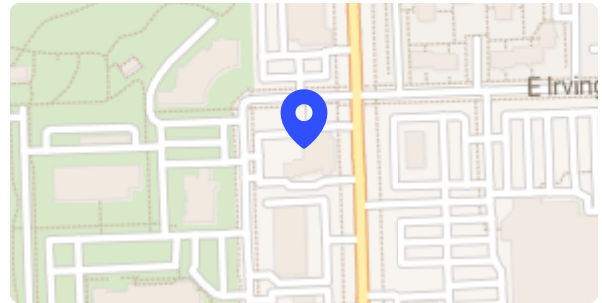
