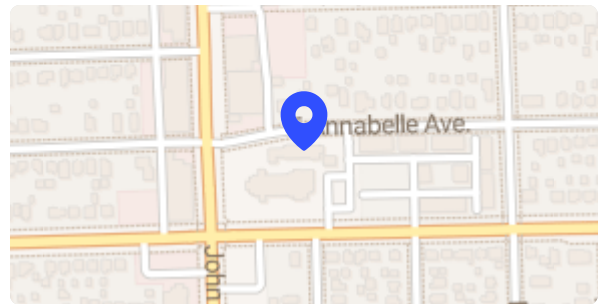
Visitation, Saturday, March 5th from 10:30 to 11:00 am at St. Mary Magdalen Church followed by 11:00 am Mass.

Burial, Christian Memorial Cemetery, Rochester Hills.



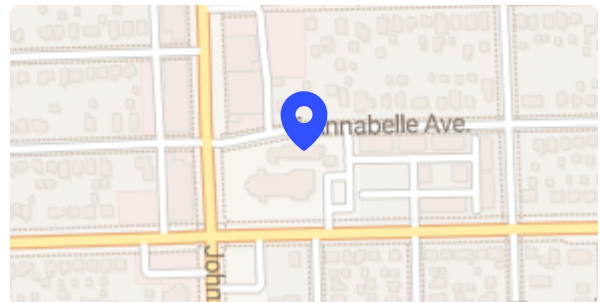

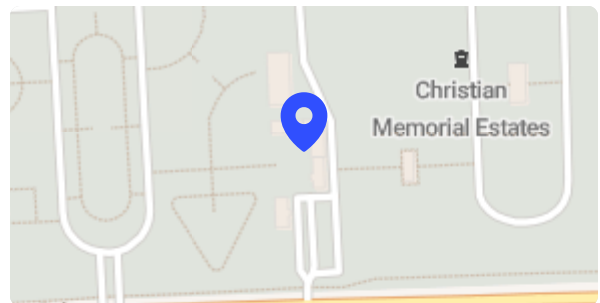
