Bettie L. Howard, 80, of Hazel Park, Michigan passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 27, 2016 in the Palliative/Hospice Unit at Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak with family by her side.

On May 20, 1936, Bettie was born as the sixth child (of 12) to Walter E. Phillips and Nora Amanda Lee Phillips (Bryant) of Hanceville, Alabama.

In 1953, Bettie married and moved to Detroit and the following year she started a family and enjoyed going to the Hudson Building to shop, going to church and was known for her incredible baked and fried apple pies and peach cobbler! In the 80s, she became a fan of the Detroit Tigers up to the very end.

Bettie loved and enjoyed her kids, grandkids, and great-grandkids (including the furry ones) as well as drinking coffee, playing bingo, Rook, Rummikub, (she was almost unbeatable at this), gardening, camping and later coloring and is a retiree of Providence Hospital in Southfield.
