Burial will take place at Great Lakes National Cemetery, Holly, Michigan with full military honors on June 21, 2017 at 11:00 am..

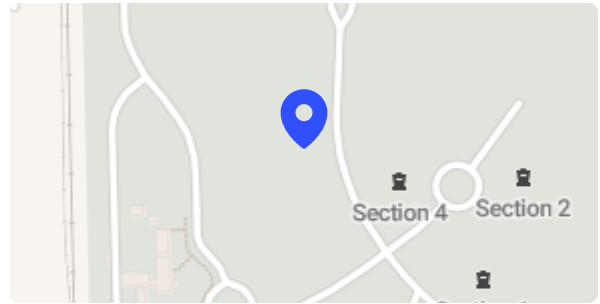

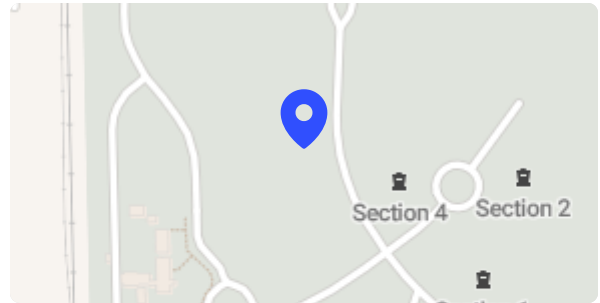
