**G**ary Lynn Neiswonger, age 72, January 24, 1947 -- December 17, 2019. His was a peaceful passing as he joined his parents, father--William Darl Neiswonger I and mother --Clara Louise (Buffington) Neiswonger, and brother --William Darl Neiswonger II. Gary is survived by his sister, Brenda Louise Neiswonger, and nephews, William Darl Neiswonger III, Edward Sloan Neiswonger, Robert William Wellbaum, Shawn Thomas Wellbaum, and nieces, Shannon Minette (Neiswonger) Acevedo, Malissa Lynn (Neiswonger) Herceg, 6 great nephews, and 7 great nieces. 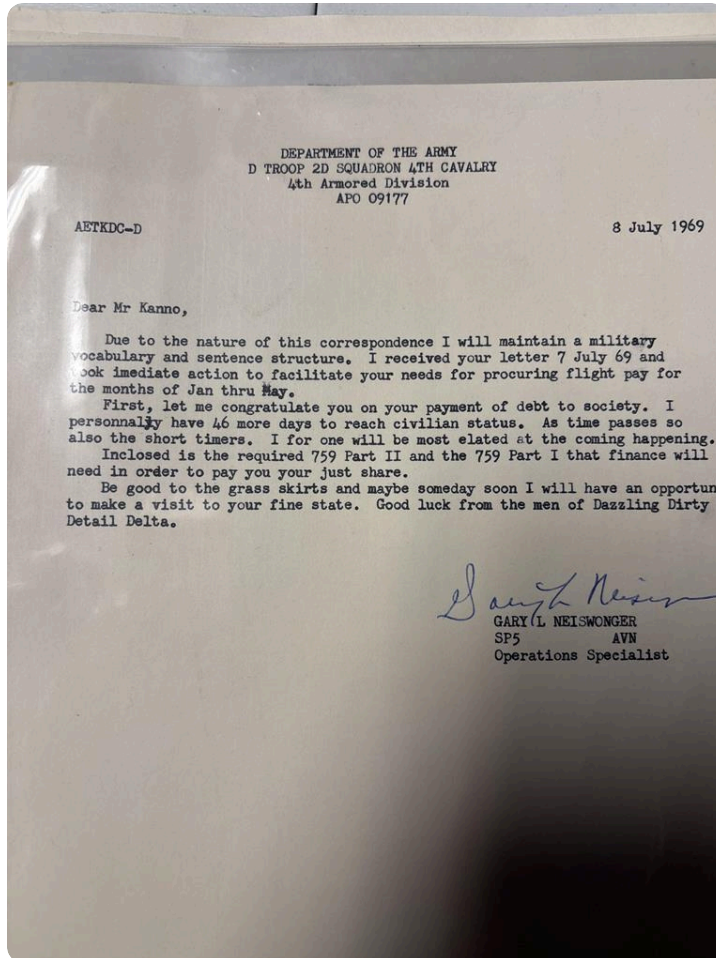
