Burial services will be held on Thursday.

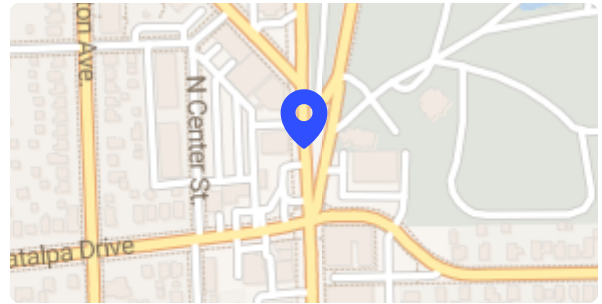
