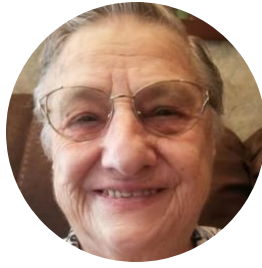

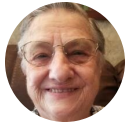
She married Frank N. Akins on July 13, 1952 in Union County, Georgia and they remained happily married until his death on April 13, 2020.

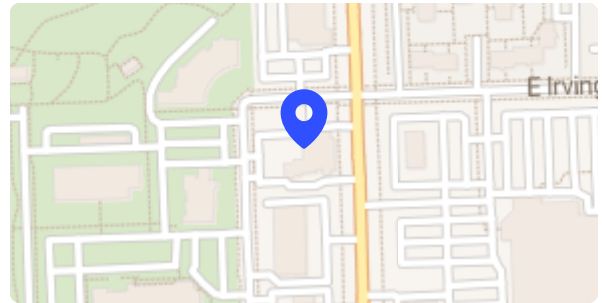


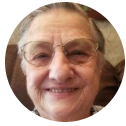

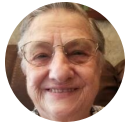
