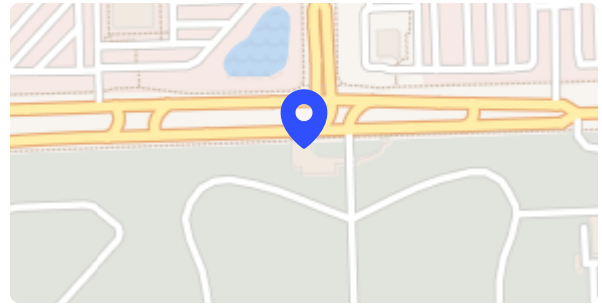

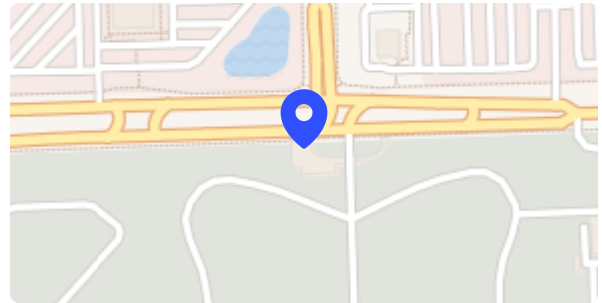

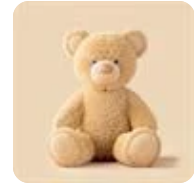

Another time I was in my backyard, Mr. Jerry gave me a pin of a painter's palette because I'm an artist. He kept track of each personality in my big family, which meant a lot. I'll miss seeing Mr. Jerry come out to do yard work or let his dog out, and hearing his jokes. He had a good sense of humor and made me laugh.
