Many Saturday nights were spent watching movies – we called it Movie Marathon and we were particularly fond of the classics, especially Wuthering Heights, anything with Bette Davis and Valley of the Dolls. My friendship with Nick pre-dates my marriage and children. He was there for so many of my major life events, most recently being a guest of honor at my son's wedding. 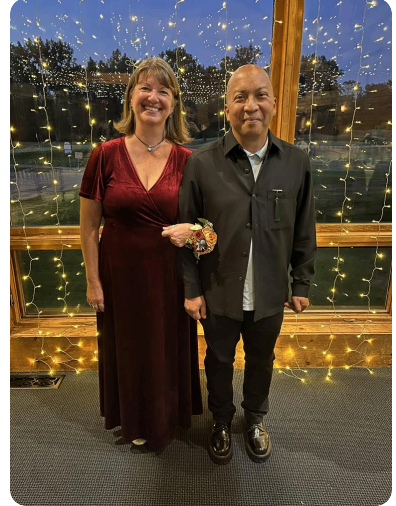
